152 trees (not 200) were received. They were not hardened down on arrival and were long time in transit. They leafed out feebly in 1927, and in March 1928 all appeared dead. About 50 were taken out to make room for other stock. Of the 104 left in the ground, 32 showed signs of basal sprouts on June 4, 1928.
