Governor Dannel P. Malloy signed the following legislation of the 2017 Regular Session on July 6:

- HB 7214 AN ACT CONCERNING HARASSMENT OF A GUIDE OR ASSISTANCE DOG OR  
PA 17-102 THE HANDLER OF SUCH DOG.  
This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- HB 7230 AN ACT CONCERNING THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE'S ELECTRONIC  
PA 17-103 BUSINESS PORTAL.  
This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- HB 7243 AN ACT CONCERNING SPECIAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT LIENS.  
PA 17-104 This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- HB 7263 AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS AND TECHNICAL CHANGES TO THE TAX  
PA 17-105 AND RELATED STATUTES, AND CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS FROM THE  
PROPERTY TAX.

- HB 7284 AN ACT CONCERNING STATE IDENTIFICATION FOR INMATES UPON  
PA 17-106 REENTRY.  
This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- HB 7296 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE FUNDING OF UNFUNDED ACCRUED MUNICIPAL  
PA 17-107 EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM LIABILITIES BY MUNICIPALITIES.  
This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
- HB 5077 AN ACT CONCERNING THE RETURN OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS TO  
PA 17-109 PHARMACIES.  
This bill shall take effect from passage.
- HB 5764 AN ACT CONCERNING THE LICENSING OF BARBERS AND HAIRDRESSERS.  
PA 17-112 This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.

- HB 5884 AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF COAL TAR SEALANTS ON STATE AND  
PA 17-113 LOCAL HIGHWAYS.  
This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- HB 5963 AN ACT INCREASING THE MINIMUM AMOUNT OF INSURANCE COVERAGE  
PA 17-114 REQUIRED TO ISSUE A MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE OR  
CERTIFICATE OF MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.  
This bill shall take effect January 1, 2018.
- HB 6266 AN ACT CONCERNING BOXING EVENTS AND MIXED MARTIAL ARTS  
PA 17-116 MATCHES.  
This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- HB 6356 AN ACT CONCERNING PUBLIC NOTICE OF TREE REMOVAL ON MUNICIPAL  
PA 17-117 PROPERTY.  
This bill shall take effect from passage.
- HB 6668 AN ACT CONCERNING PREGNANT WOMEN IN THE WORKPLACE.  
PA 17-118 This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- SB 129 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TAKING OF MUSHROOMS AT STATE PARKS AND  
PA 17-150 ON OTHER STATE PROPERTY.  
This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- SB 548 AN ACT CONCERNING HAIRDRESSERS AND COSMETICIANS.  
PA 17-152 This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- SB 546 AN ACT CONCERNING PARTICIPATING PROVIDER DIRECTORIES AND  
PA 17-154 PROVIDERS ACCEPTING NEW PATIENTS ON AN OUTPATIENT SERVICES  
BASIS.  
This bill shall take effect January 1, 2018.
- SB 922 AN ACT CONCERNING TEMPORARY HEALTH CARE STRUCTURES.  
PA 17-155 This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- HB 5116 AN ACT CONCERNING PUBLIC ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION AND  
PA 17-156 EMPLOYMENT DATA.  
This bill shall take effect October 1, 2017.
- HB 5140 AN ACT CONCERNING REIMBURSEMENTS TO HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS  
PA 17-157 FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES.  
This bill shall take effect January 1, 2018.
- HB 7253 AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS AND ADDITIONS TO THE  
PA 17-173 EDUCATION STATUTES.  
This bill has various effective dates. Refer to the text [here](#).
- HB 7251 AN ACT CONCERNING REFORM DISTRICT TURNAROUND PLANS.  
PA 17-215 This bill shall take effect July 1, 2017.
