FULL CPAT 5-DAY SESSION

The five-day CPAT class consists of 2 orientations sessions, 2 practice tests and final CPAT test day, all spaced 2 weeks apart. It's specifically designed for the first time candidate. The 2 Orientation sessions give the candidate an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the test equipment and then gauge their training progress. The combination of the two practice tests and final test allow the candidate 3 opportunities to earn their CPAT certificate.

The presentations at the two orientations are the same. It will explain the testing process and how the equipment works. You will have the chance to ask questions and try the testing equipment. The pass rate of those who attend the orientation sessions is higher than for those who do not. The practice tests and final test will be stopped if the candidate exceeds the allowed warnings at each station, meets a failure criteria at any station of if the 10:20 countdown timer reaches 0:00. Our licensing agreement requires us to pay strict attention to the weather conditions to assure the test is administered in a fair and equitable manner. If the weather cancellation conditions are reached, (temperature below 45°F, Apparent Heat Index greater than 95°F, sustained winds greater than 20 mph or any measurable amount of rain), the test day will be terminated and candidates rescheduled to another day. If favorable weather conditions are maintained and the candidate successfully completes the practice test, this is considered a PASS and you will not need to attend any further testing. At the end of each test, you must report to the rehab area to be medically evaluated and complete the required paperwork.
