

On arrival, Engine 3 found heavy fire from underneath the car and the engine compartment. Companies attempted to use water for about 8 minutes before switching to foam, which quickly took care of the fire. Engine 2 responded to the scene after clearing from a medical call to assist with hazard mitigation in checking storm drains and manholes for fuel and foam runoff. All visible smoke was gone by 7:30, an hour since the time of alarm. In the end, a 2012 Porsche Boxster was totaled. The last remaining unit cleared past 10pm after investigation by the DEEP and cleanup of foam and fuel.





