Ruling re: the respondents' motion to dismiss

On September 23, 2010, the complainant filed a complaint with the chief human rights referee alleging that the respondents had violated General Statutes § 4-61dd. On September 29, 2009, the respondents filed a motion to dismiss the complaint alleging that they were not a quasi-state agency or a large state contractor as alleged in the complaint and as required by the statute (motion).

As more than ten days have elapsed since the filing of the motion; Regs., Conn. State Agencies § 4-61dd-14; and as the complainant has filed no objection to the motion, the motion is granted and the case is dismissed. The initial conference, previously scheduled for October 19, 2010, and the hearing, previously scheduled for August 2-4 and 9-12, 2011, are cancelled.
