NOTICE OF HEARING AND APPOINTMENT OF HEARING OFFICER

Notice is hereby given you, The Alieria Companies, Inc., Petitioner herein, that the 7th day of February, 2020, at 10:00 a.m., is hereby fixed as the time when a public hearing will be held in the offices of the Connecticut Insurance Department, 153 Market Street, 7th Floor, Hartford, CT, pursuant to your request for a hearing received on or about January 2, 2020, at which time and place you will have the right to appear before the duly designated Hearing Officer, to show cause why an order of the Insurance Commissioner dated December 2, 2019 directing you to cease and desist from conducting an unauthorized insurance business in Connecticut should not stand.

A pre-hearing Conference, to be attended in person at the offices of the Insurance Department at the address stated herein, is scheduled for January 22, 2020 from 11:00 am to 12:00 pm. and shall be conducted in accordance with Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies § 38a-8-38.


The legal authority and jurisdiction for the hearing in this matter are contained in Sections 38a-19 and 4-166 *et seq.* of the Connecticut General Statutes, and Section 38a-8-30, *et seq.* of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

Pursuant to R.C.S.A. § 38a-8-33, you and/or your representative are directed to file a Notice of Appearance with the Commissioner that must be received on or before January 31, 2020 (“appearance date”). Failure to appear by the appearance date will permit the Commissioner, at his discretion, to note such failure upon the record and render a decision by default. A withdrawal of a request for a hearing must be effected by filing with the Hearing Officer a written statement in such regard on or before the appearance date.
