ORDER

I, Katharine L. Wade, Insurance Commissioner of the State of Connecticut, do hereby issue the following order, TO WIT:

- 1. On September 7, 2017, the rate application filed by Anthem Health Plans, Inc. d/b/a Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield ("Anthem"), to be effective January 1, 2018, for its individual on and off exchange plans was disapproved in accordance with General Statutes § 38a-481, and Anthem was thereafter authorized to submit revised rates for review to be consistent with the recommendations set forth in the Proposed Final Decision issued by Jared Kosky, Hearing Officer, on September 7, 2017.
2. On September 12, 2017, Anthem did submit such revised rates consistent with the recommendations set forth in the Proposed Final Decision resulting in an average rate increase of 31.7%. Such rates are found to be adequate, not excessive and not unfairly discriminatory in accordance with General Statutes § 38a-481 and are hereby approved.
