## **NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND A REGULATION**

In accordance with section 4-168(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Insurance Commissioner, pursuant to the authority of section 38a-138 of the Connecticut General Statutes, proposes to amend regulations concerning the Insurance Holding Company Act.

**Statement of purpose:** This proposed amended regulation will require that the filing of Forms A and E include an electronic copy and reduces the number of paper copies required to be filed. It also amends the regulation to require that Forms B, C, D, D-1 and F now only be filed electronically. The amendments also make a number of technical corrections to other portions of the regulations and appendices. No other laws or regulations will be affected. The amendments relate to filings required of insurance companies that are not small businesses.

All interested persons are invited to submit written data, views or arguments in connection with the proposed action within thirty days following publication of this notice on the e-regulations system and in the Connecticut Law Journal either electronically via the e-regulations system or to the State of Connecticut, Insurance Department, Attention: Jared T. Kosky, P.O. Box 816, Hartford, CT 06142-0816.

In addition to accepting written public comment, the Insurance Department will hold a public hearing on the proposed amendments to the regulation on September 10, 2018 at 9:00 a.m., at the Insurance Department, 153 Market Street, 7<sup>th</sup> floor, Room 701, Hartford, CT 06103. Oral comments presented at the hearing should summarize written comments submitted to the Insurance Department prior to the hearing. Oral comments will be time limited and must address the proposed amendments to the regulation.
