RE: DOCKET NO. 516 – The United Illuminating Company (UI) application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Fairfield to Congress Railroad Transmission Line 115-kV Rebuild Project that consists of the relocation and rebuild of its existing 115- kilovolt (kV) electric transmission lines from the railroad catenary structures to new steel monopole structures and related modifications along approximately 7.3 miles of the Connecticut Department of Transportation's Metro-North Railroad corridor between Structure B648S located east of Sasco Creek in Fairfield and UI's Congress Street Substation in Bridgeport, and the rebuild of two existing 115-kV transmission lines along 0.23 mile of existing UI right-of-way to facilitate interconnection of the rebuilt 115-kV electric transmission lines at UI's existing Ash Creek, Resco, Pequonnock and Congress Street Substations traversing the municipalities of Bridgeport and Fairfield, Connecticut.

Motions

1. United Illuminating Company Request for Additional Witness, dated November 20, 2023

This request was withdrawn on November 27, 2023.

2. Sasco Creek Neighborhood Environmental Trust, Inc. Motion to Preclude Witness, dated November 21, 2023

UI's withdrawal of its November 20, 2023 request for an additional witness rendered this motion moot.

3. City of Bridgeport Request for Party and CEPA Intervenor Status, dated November 22, 2023

This request was granted.

4. Sasco Creek Neighborhood Environmental Trust, Inc. Motion for Reconsideration, dated November 27, 2023

This request was denied on the bases that the Council makes the final determination as to relevance in its proceedings consistent with the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act and the Council's Rules of Practice; the proprietary and critical energy infrastructure information requested is defined by federal law, exempt from disclosure under state law, not required to be submitted into the record by any provision of the statutes and determined by the Council to be beyond what is necessary for it to render a decision on this application; and the information

requested in this proceeding was not necessary for the Council to render decisions in Docket Nos. 3B and 508.

5. Grouped LLC Intervenors Motion to Dismiss and/or Stay Proceedings, dated November 27, 2023

A ruling on this request was deferred until the other parties and intervenors to this proceeding have an opportunity to comment on the Motion in post-hearing briefs.

Continuation of Evidentiary Hearing
