

SIGN POSTING AFFIDAVIT

I, Mark Mirabito, being duly sworn, deposes and states that:

1. I am over eighteen years of age and I understand the obligations of a statement under oath.

2. I am the Vice President of NTE Connecticut, LLC ("NTE").

3. NTE has proposed the establishment of an electric power generating facility at 180 and 189 Lake Road in Killingly, Connecticut (collectively, the "Site").

4. Under my direction, NTE was responsible for the posting two "Public Notice Signs" at the Site.

5. In accordance with Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") guidelines, the public notice signs were posted on October 4, 2016.
