During the limited evidentiary hearing session held by the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) on March 23, 2017, the Council voted on the following requests:

a. NAPP, Wyndham Land Trust, the Connecticut Fund for the Environment, and the Sierra Club Joint Request for Administrative Notice, dated March 16, 2017

This request was granted.

b. NAPP, Wyndham Land Trust, and the Sierra Club Joint Request for Administrative Notice, dated March 21, 2017

This request was denied on the basis that it is beyond the scope of the limited proceeding, and it is a draft document that is subject to change.

2. Close of Record Date

The evidentiary record for the above-referenced matter will close on April 24, 2017.

Parties and intervenors may file briefs and proposed findings of fact with the Council no later than **April 24, 2017**. No new information, no new evidence, no argument and no reply briefs will be considered without permission from the Council.
