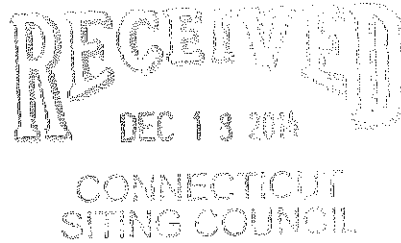

***Re: Docket 192B-Towantic Energy, LLC Motion to Reopen and Modify the June 23, 1999 Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need based on changed conditions pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-181a(b) for the construction, maintenance and operation of a 785 Megawatt dual-fuel combined cycle electric generating facility located north of the Prokop Road and Towantic Hill Road intersection in the Town of Oxford, Connecticut.***

Dear Attorney Bachman,

In accordance with your requests in your notice dated Dec. 12, 2014, of the pre-hearing conference to be held on Dec. 18, 2014, at 2:00 p.m. in Hearing Room #1 at your offices in New Britain, following are my responses, both as an individual intervenor and for the Town of Middlebury as its duly authorized Representative to the Waterbury-Oxford Airport.

I plan to address the following subjects:

1. Recent aeronautical findings (subsequent to the November 3, 2005 re-opening by the Council under CGS 4-181a(b), including FAA Position Paper dated July 8, 2014.
2. New information with respect to the natural gas shortage in Northeast portion of the US.
3. Added pollution and harmful air emissions.
4. Aviation Obstacles at the Waterbury-Oxford Airport.
5. FAA Grant Assurances.

I hope to have four witnesses who are licensed pilots testify, or submit affidavits.

Interrogatories

1. Provide cut sheets (sales brochures) on the GE #7HA.01 turbines
2. Provide detailed drawings of Stacks #1 & #2, preferably by the stack manufacturer, giving all dimensions and appurtenances
3. How does repositioning of the stacks reduce potential impacts on air navigation from the Waterbury-Oxford Airport?
4. There may be additional interrogatories following receipt and review of the requested information.
