NOTIFICATION PURSUANT TO C.G.S. § 16-50l(e)

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50l(e), attached are materials that Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Cellco”) is required to provide to the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) in connection with its proposed wireless telecommunications facility on property owned by the Town of Farmington (“Town”) at 199 Town Farm Road, Farmington, Connecticut (the “Farmington North 2 Facility”). These include:

- A. All materials provided to the Town;
 - B. A summary of the consultations with the Town, including any recommendations on the proposed telecommunications facility; and
 - C. Copies of all correspondence between Cellco and the Town.
- A. Materials Provided to the Town of Farmington
- 1. Memorandum, dated May 8, 2007, from Mike Libertine, Vanasse Hangen Brustlin, Inc., to Jeffrey Ollendorf, Town Planner, regarding monopine installation photographs, attached behind Tab 1.

2. Letter, dated June 5, 2007, from Kenneth C. Baldwin, Robinson & Cole LLP, to Jeffrey Ollendorf, Town Planner, regarding photosimulations, attached behind Tab 2.

3. Technical Report, dated September 14, 2007, prepared by Celco and provided to the Town and the Town of Avon. This information includes a description of the proposed wireless facility, the need for such facility and the description of other sites considered, but found to be unacceptable. Copies of the technical information were submitted to the Council as a Bulk File Exhibit on February 2, 2008.

4. Letter, dated March 19, 2008, from Joey Lee Miranda, Robinson & Cole LLP, to Jeffrey Ollendorf, Town Planner, regarding concerns raised by Ronald Simmons, attached behind Tab 3.

5. Letter, dated March 21, 2008, from Joey Lee Miranda, Robinson & Cole LLP, to Jeffrey Ollendorf, Town Planner, regarding visibility from the Devonwood neighborhood, attached behind Tab 4.

B. Summary of Municipal Consultations

1. Celco representatives attended a July 23, 2007 public meeting of the Town Plan and Zoning Commission ("Commission") regarding the lease between Celco and the Town and presented information regarding the proposed Farmington North 2 Facility. At that meeting, the Commission voted to issue a report pursuant to section 8-24 of the Connecticut General Statutes referring the lease to the Town Council for approval. Copies of the agenda and minutes from this meeting were submitted to the Council in response to Interrogatory 16.

2. Celco representatives attended an August 14, 2007 public meeting of the Town Council regarding the lease between Celco and the Town and presented information regarding the proposed Farmington North 2 Facility. At that meeting, the Town Council authorized the

Town Manager to sign and enter into the lease. Copies of the agenda and minutes from this meeting were submitted to the Council in response to Interrogatory 16.

3. On September 14, 2007, Cellco representatives met with Farmington Town Manager Kathleen Eagen and Avon Town Manager Philip K. Schenk, Jr. to commence the sixty (60) day municipal consultation process. At these meetings, both Town Managers received copies of the Technical Report summarizing Cellco's plans to establish a telecommunications facility in Farmington.


4. On February 14, 2008, Town Planner Jeffrey Ollendorf contacted Cellco representatives regarding concerns raised by Ronald Simmons about the proposed Farmington North 2 Facility. On March 19, 2008, Cellco sent Mr. Ollendorf a letter addressing those concerns.

5. In February 2008, Town Planner Jeffrey Ollendorf contacted Cellco representatives inquiring about the visibility of the proposed Farmington North 2 Facility from the Devonwood neighborhood. On March 21, 2008, Cellco sent Mr. Ollendorf a letter responding to his inquiry.

C. Copies of all correspondence between Cellco and the Town of Farmington

Other than the Cellco Technical Report, which was submitted as a Bulk File Exhibit on February 2, 2008, copies of all correspondence between Cellco and the Town regarding the proposed Farmington North 2 Facility are included behind Tabs 1 through 4 attached hereto.
