

NOTIFICATION PURSUANT TO C.G.S. § 16-50I(e)

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50I(e), attached are materials which Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Cellco”) is required to provide to the Siting Council (“Council”) in connection with its proposed wireless telecommunications facility on property off Sterling Road, Plainfield (Moosup), Connecticut (the “Moosup Facility”). These include:

- A. All materials provided to the Town of Plainfield;
 - B. A summary of the consultations with the Town of Plainfield, including any recommendations on the proposed telecommunications facility; and
 - C. Copies of any and all correspondence between the Cellco and the Town of Plainfield.
- A. Materials Provided to the Town of Plainfield

Technical Report dated June 11, 2008, prepared by Cellco. This information includes a description of the proposed wireless facility, the need for such facility and the description of

other sites considered, but found to be unacceptable. Copies of the technical information were submitted to the Council as a Bulk File Exhibit on August 26, 2008.


B. Summary of Municipal Consultations

On June 11, 2008, Cellco representatives met with Plainfield First Selectman Paul E. Sweet to discuss the proposed telecommunications facility described in the Siting Council application and the Council's application procedures. Cellco offered to appear before the Board of Selectmen or any of the Town's land use boards or commissions to discuss the proposed telecommunications facility. Cellco was not asked to appear at any municipal proceeding. As a matter of practice, Cellco will attempt to contact First Selectman Sweet prior to the Council's hearing to discuss or address any new or outstanding issues.

C. Copies of all correspondence between the Cellco and the Town of Putnam

Other than the Cellco Technical Report, no pre-application correspondence was generated or received regarding the proposed Moosup Facility.
