To Our Neighbors of St. Matthew Lutheran Church:

I trust this official letter will serve to clarify the position of St. Matthew Lutheran Church, both now and into the future.

After discussion with the Church Council of St. Matthew Lutheran Church on 3 August, 2010 a clear consensus was reached that St. Matthew Lutheran Church has no interest in a second or subsequent cellular phone tower on the property of the Church, the parcel known as 224 Lovely Street. We are in fact, against such an occurrence.

This cell tower approval process has become a long and difficult process for all involved; we at St. Matthew have followed advice to keep silence during the negotiation of the continually changing picture concerning the possibility of a communications cell tower on our property.

At this time we are willing to clearly affirm that a second or subsequent cellular phone tower with AT& T or another carrier, shall not be constructed, maintained, or used on the property of the Church. We trust this statement creates a solution which resolves concerns regarding the future use of this property in the best interests of the Town of Avon, and other interested parties.
