I write on behalf of the Applicant, T-Mobile Northeast LLC ("T-Mobile"), regarding the above-captioned docket. T-Mobile respectfully requests that the Council (1) table this matter at its September 7, 2010 meeting and (2) grant an extension of time for the Council to render its decision on the telecommunications facility proposed by T-Mobile at 208 Valley Road, New Canaan, Connecticut ("Facility").


T-Mobile recently learned that AT&T is interested in locating its antennas on the Facility. T-Mobile would like to adjust the Facility's configuration to accommodate AT&T, as well as T-Mobile and Verizon, and remain consistent with the property owner's wishes regarding the Facility. This additional time would enable T-Mobile to resolve an existing coverage gap for multiple wireless providers in New Canaan ("Town"). The Town has stated for the record that it would like this coverage gap remedied. Moreover, an extension of time would allow T-Mobile to embrace fully the legislative directive in favor of co-location.

Accordingly, T-Mobile respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension of time for the Council to render its decision regarding the Facility pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50p and § 16-50j-6 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.
