RE: **DOCKET NO. 424** - The Connecticut Light & Power Company Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Connecticut portion of the Interstate Reliability Project that traverses the municipalities of Lebanon, Columbia, Coventry, Mansfield, Chaplin, Hampton, Brooklyn, Pomfret, Killingly, Putnam, Thompson, and Windham, which consists of (a) new overhead 345-kV electric transmission lines and associated facilities extending between CL&P's Card Street Substation in the Town of Lebanon, Lake Road Switching Station in the Town of Killingly, and the Connecticut/Rhode Island border in the Town of Thompson; and (b) related additions at CL&P's existing Card Street Substation, Lake Road Switching Station, and Killingly Substation.


Pursuant to a decision made in accordance with R.C.S.A. §16-50j-62 (b) at a public meeting of the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) held on September 19, 2013, and in response to your email of March 10, 2015, Council staff hereby approves a temporary change to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan to allow construction activities associated with the above project to occur at Card Street Substation in Lebanon from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM on the following Sundays: March 15, March 22, and March 29, 2015. The Sunday work hours are required to allow critical activities to be completed during a major CONVEX-approved outage that is scheduled for the second half of March. All work would be within the substation fence line.

This approval applies only to the Sunday work hours requested in your email of March 10, 2015. Any additional changes to the D&M Plan require advance notification and approval in accordance with the Council's approval of the Substation D&M Plan on September 19, 2013. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62.

Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Pursuant to Section 16-50j-62(a)(1) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) and Sections 4 and 7.2 of the *Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the Construction of the Interstate Reliability Project (Project, Interstate) Modifications to Card Street Substation, Lake Road Switching Station, and Killingly Substation*, The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P), doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource), requests that the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) review and approve Project work on three Sundays in March at Card Street Substation (Town of Lebanon).

The Sunday work is required to allow the performance of Project critical activities (e.g., re-wiring and testing breakers) that must be completed during a major CONVEX-approved outage, which is scheduled for the latter half of the month. Accordingly, Eversource requests that the Council approve 12-hour work days (7 AM to 7PM) on the following Sundays: March 15, March 22, and March 29, 2015. All work will be performed within the substation fence line. Eversource will inform Town of Lebanon representatives concerning the Sunday work.
