Dear Chairman Stein and Executive Director Bachman:

Please accept this letter from InSite Towers Development, LLC and on behalf of New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (“AT&T”) regarding the captioned Facility for which the Siting Council issued a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need in Docket 441 (“Certificate”).

Condition 6 of the Decision and Order dated March 6, 2014 required the approved facility to be fully constructed and providing wireless services within eighteen (18) months from the date of the mailing of the Council’s Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order.

Although the tower is constructed and the Town’s public safety equipment is partially installed, AT&T continues at this time to make arrangements for the installation of their communication data service to the tower site. In keeping with Condition 7 of the Decision and Order, we respectfully request an extension of the Certificate’s allowed completion time for an additional eighteen (18) months which would extend out to March 6, 2017.
