Dear Ms. Shanley:

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62 (b) and in accordance with the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council) Decision and Order for the above referenced project, dated November 9, 2017, Council staff hereby approves the continued use of a temporary material laydown/staging area located at the Bruce Museum in Greenwich until June 1, 2020, as detailed in Eversource's correspondence dated December 20, 2019.

The staging area/laydown area will be used to store Project construction materials and support equipment, and may be accessed 24 hours a day, depending on the Project's day-or night-time construction activities.

This approval applies only to the continued use of the temporary material laydown/staging area as detailed in Eversource's correspondence of December 20, 2019. Any additional changes to the approved D&M Plan require advance notification and approval. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62. Please be advised that deviations from the D&M Plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.



Dear Ms. Bachman:

On June 6, 2019, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) staff approved the above-referenced 3,500-square-foot temporary staging/laydown area for use during the construction of The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy's (Eversource's) Greenwich Substation and Line Project (Project). Originally, pursuant to an agreement between Eversource's transmission line contractor and Bruce Museum, the staging/laydown area was to be used from June 15 to December 30, 2019.

To facilitate the ongoing installation of the Project's underground transmission lines, Eversource's transmission line contractor now has reached an agreement with Bruce Museum to extend the use of the staging/laydown area until June 1, 2020. The area, which is enclosed with a temporary chain link fence and locked gate, will continue to be used to store Project construction materials and support equipment, and may be accessed 24 hours a day, depending on the Project's approved day-or night-time construction activities. Use of the area for Project activities does not interfere with pedestrian or vehicular access to the Museum.

Pursuant to Sections C.2.1 and F.2 of the Project's above-referenced Development and Management (D&M) Plan, Eversource seeks Council staff approval for the extended use of the temporary staging/laydown area in the Bruce Museum parking lot.
