As you know, on January 19, 2018, NTE Connecticut, LLC (“NTE”) filed a Motion to Reopen and Modify the Decision in Docket No. 470 Due to Changed Conditions (“Motion”) as described in the Motion. On February 5, 2018, NTE participated in the ISO-NE Forward Capacity Auction No. 12 (“FCA 12”).

Late yesterday afternoon, NTE was notified that the Killingly Energy Center (“KEC”) was not selected by ISO-NE to receive a capacity supply obligation (“CSO”) in FCA 12. NTE has, therefore, decided to withdraw its Motion.
