RE: **DOCKET NO. F-2012/2013** – Connecticut Siting Council Review of the Ten-Year Forecast of Connecticut Electric Loads and Resources

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During the evidentiary hearing held on June 12, 2012 for the above-referenced matter, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) requested the following additional information be submitted as late-filed exhibits:

**ISO New England, Inc. (ISO-NE)**

- Provide the 2002 ISO-NE 50/50 10-year (2002 to 2011) load and energy forecast for Connecticut. (Include weather-normalized historical peak load data for Connecticut for 2002 to 2011, if available.)
- Indicate whether there is a maximum time limit for projects to be in the generation interconnection queue. In other words, after a certain (maximum) period of time of being in the queue, could a generator “time out” and be automatically removed from the queue?

**Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc.**

- For countries that reprocess nuclear fuel, do they reprocess the fuel on site (at the nuclear power plant) or at a separate facility?
- Is the United States the only country that does not reprocess nuclear fuel? If no, what other countries with nuclear power do not reprocess nuclear fuel?

**Connecticut Municipal Electric Energy Cooperative (CMEEC)**

- In CMEEC’s response to Council interrogatory CSC-1, explain the decrease in the projected residential service sales from 2019 to 2020?

**The United Illuminating Company (UI)**

- In UI’s response to Council interrogatory CSC-3 dated May 11, 2012, UI provided a conservation impact table. Provide a similar table for load management.
- Provide the number and kW of solar (photovoltaic) projects installed in UI’s territory. (Either list all known projects, or at least for the past few years, if available.)

**The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P)**

- Provide the number and kW of solar (photovoltaic) projects installed in CL&P's territory. (Either list all known projects, or at least for the past few years, if available.)

If it has not been filed already, the Council requests that this additional information be submitted to the Council and parties and intervenors on or before July 12, 2012.
