**CMEEC Pre-Hearing Interrogatories**

1. Provide the predicted (not actual) 50/50 forecast loads for 2002 through 2011 from The Connecticut Municipal Electric Energy Cooperative's (CMEEC) 2002 forecast report.
2. Provide CMEEC's weather-normalized historical peak loads for 2002 through 2011.
3. Explain the methodology of how historical actual peak load data are converted to weather-normalized historical peak load data.
4. Provide CMEEC's predicted load factors for years 2012 through 2021 using the normal weather forecast.
5. Provide a break-down of the projected number of megawatts (MW) of load reduction for CMEEC's territory due to conservation, load response/load management, and distributed generation (if applicable) for each year from 2012 through 2021. If possible, also include a similar estimated break-down by megawatt-hours or gigawatt-hours.
6. Provide the basic underlying assumptions associated with the distributed generation (DG) included in the 2012 CMEEC Forecast, including but not limited to the DG projects approved, number of megawatts of each DG project, the number of units expected to go into service or the assumed probability that they will go into service, etc.
7. Does CMEEC's 2012 Forecast include any additions due to possible loads and/or electrical energy consumption from electric vehicles? If yes, provide any assumptions made regarding electric vehicles.
