Dear Mr. Atkins:

Section 16-50r of the Connecticut General Statutes requires that all persons generating electric power utilizing a generating facility with a capacity greater than one megawatt shall file with the Connecticut Siting Council, on or before March 1, an annual report that includes the following information:

- 1) A tabulation of estimated peak loads, resources and margins;
- 2) Data on use and peak loads for the preceding calendar years;
- 3) A list of generating facilities in service;
- 4) A list of scheduled generating facilities for which property has been acquired, for which certificates have been issued, and for which certificated applications have been filed;
- 5) A list of planned generating units at plant locations for which property has been acquired;
- 6) A list of planned transmission lines on which proposed route reviews are being undertaken or for which certificate applications have been filed;
- 7) A description of steps taken to upgrade existing facilities; and
- 8) For each private power producer having a facility generating more than one megawatt and from whom the person furnishing the report has purchased electricity during the preceding calendar year, a statement including the name, location, size and type of generating facility, the fuel consumed by the facility and the by-product of the consumption.

As of this date, the Connecticut Siting Council has not received the statutorily required report from your generating facility. Please submit the report as soon as possible.
