NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT SESSION ON THE 2017 TEN-YEAR FORECAST OF ELECTRIC LOADS AND RESOURCES AND THE 2017 ANALYSIS OF LIFE CYCLE COSTS OF ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION LINES

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) will conduct a public comment session on Tuesday, May 9, 2017, to provide an opportunity for public comment on the 2017 Ten-Year Forecast of Connecticut Electric Loads and Resources and the 2017 Analysis of Life Cycle Costs of Electric Transmission Lines. The public comment session will be held in Hearing Room Two, Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut, beginning at 6:30 p.m., and thereafter as necessary.

Pursuant to CGS §16-50r, the Council shall hold at least one session of a public hearing no earlier than 6:30 p.m. The scope of the 2017 Forecast of Electric Loads and Resources shall cover a ten-year forecast period. The Council will issue a final biennial report in late 2017. The scope of the 2017 Analysis of Life Cycle Costs of Electric Transmission Lines shall include an inquiry of all relevant electric transmission line life cycle costs, relative reliability, constraints concerning access and construction, potential damage to the environment and compatibility with the existing electric supply system. The Council will update, as necessary, the 2012 Analysis of Life Cycle Costs of Electric Transmission Lines in late 2017.

Any person who is not a participant to the proceedings may file a written statement with the Council at the public comment session or any time up to 30 days thereafter. Such statements will become part of the record.

Requests for information in alternative formats or for sign-language interpreter services must be submitted in writing by May 2, 2017.
