RE: PETITION NO. 1010 - New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed installation of an concealed tower on a water tank and associated equipment at a water treatment plant located at 455 Valley Road, Greenwich, Connecticut.

In response to your request of January 25, 2012, on February 2, 2012, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) granted intervenor status under C.G.S. § 16-50n and C.G.S. § 4-177a, and CEPA intervention status under C.G.S. § 22a-19 in Petition No. 1010 to Lee & Kaori Higgins, Peter & Elizabeth Janis, and Richard & Susan Kosinski.

All filings submitted to the Council must consist of an original and 15 copies with the docket number, properly collated and paginated, and bound. In accordance with the State Solid Waste Management Plan, the Council is requesting that all filings be submitted on recyclable paper, primarily regular weight white office paper.
