
The Connecticut Light and Power Company (“CL&P”) doing business as Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) received acknowledgement from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) on October 7, 2019 that Eversource’s proposed modification of the Torrington Substation would comply with the exempt modification criteria in Section 16-50j-57 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. The Council included conditions regarding the work undertaken pursuant to modification. Eversource submits this letter to provide notice that Eversource has complied with the Council’s conditions as follows:

- Written notification to the Council not less than 45 days after construction has been completed. Eversource completed construction on May 13, 2020; this letter provides notice of completion of this modification.
- There were no material changes or other deviations to this modification.
