Dear Ms. Iliades:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) received a notice of intent to modify the above-referenced facility on January 21, 2020.

According to Section 16-50j-71 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, "...any modification, as defined in Section 16-50j-2a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, to an existing tower site, except as specified in Sections 16-50j-72 and 16-50j-88 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, may have a substantial adverse environmental effect."

Staff has reviewed this exempt modification request for completeness and has identified a deficiency in the submittal. The exempt modification request lacks documentation of the original facility approval and any conditions of such approval or correspondence with the Town of Stonington stating that the town no longer retains records of its decision.

Therefore, the exempt modification request is incomplete at this time. The Council recommends that Centerline Communications provide documentation showing the original facility approval with conditions if any or correspondence with the Town stating that there are no records of the original facility approval, on or before February 24, 2020. If additional time is needed to gather the requested information, please submit a written request for an extension of time prior to February 24, 2020. **Please provide an electronic version and one hard copy of the response for the incomplete request to be rendered complete and processed. Please include the Council's exempt modification identification number referenced above with the submittal.**

This notice of incompleteness shall have the effect of tolling the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) 60-day timeframe in accordance with Paragraph 217 of the FCC Wireless Infrastructure Report and Order issued on October 21, 2014 (FCC 14-153).



In addition to the planting around the tower enclosure, plant three deciduous trees in the front portion of the site in the locations indicated in the attached sketch plan and as follows: 1- Red Maple (Acer rubrum) and 2 Winter King Hawthorn (Crataegus viridis 'Winter King'), 2 inch caliper minimum at time of planting.



1. Show the location of erosion & sedimentation devices on the plan.
2. Provide the geotechnical information to the Town Engineer which includes soil types and bearing capacity of the soils found on this site.
3. Clean up the lot: remove existing Russian Olive and other weedy vegetation, grade and bring in loam, apply an ecology grass seed mixture which will require mowing only once or twice a year.
