Dear Ms. Roberts:

BNE Energy, Inc. (“BNE”) hereby submits a revision to its D&M Plan. Specifically, BNE is submitting three hard copies of its revised Stormwater Management Plan with Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan, 3 hard copies of its revised Erosion and Sediment Control Plan, and 15 copies of corresponding full-size maps and drawings. In addition, I am enclosing 3 CDs which contain electronic versions of these materials.

As you will see from the enclosed materials, the revisions to the D&M Plan focus on a redesigned driveway, which will involve less cutting and filling and less clearing than the original D&M Plan. As a result, BNE believes that the resulting D&M Plan will provide greater protection to the environment than the previous D&M Plan.

BNE respectfully requests that the Siting Council approve this D&M Plan revision. We trust that this information is sufficient to include this submittal on the Council’s Agenda for an upcoming meeting. If that is not the case, please contact me at your convenience.
