RE: **PE1133-CING-20200304** – New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T) sub-petition for a declaratory ruling for approval of an eligible facility request for modifications to an existing telecommunications facility located at 12-14 Carpenter Road, Bolton, Connecticut.

Dear Attorney Chiocchio:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) hereby approves your Eligible Facilities Request (EFR) to install antennas and associated equipment at the above-referenced facility pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission Wireless Infrastructure Report and Order, with the following conditions:

1. Prior to AT&T's antenna installation, the tower modifications shall be installed in accordance with the Structural Analysis prepared by Tower Engineering Solutions, dated February 11, 2020 and stamped and signed by Jarryd Tibbets;
2. Prior to AT&T's antenna installation, the antenna mount shall be installed in accordance with the Mount Analysis prepared by Infinigy, dated October 29, 2019 and stamped and signed by John S. Stevens;
3. Within 45 days following completion of equipment installation, AT&T shall provide documentation certified by a Professional Engineer that its installation complied with the recommendations of the Mount Analysis;
4. If there is currently no existing caution 2B sign at the base of the tower, then one must be installed upon the installation of the proposed AT&T antennas, consistent with the Non-Ionizing Radiation Report prepared by Infinigy dated February 13, 2020;
5. Approval of any minor changes be delegated to Council staff;
6. Within 45 days after completion of construction, the Council shall be notified in writing that construction has been completed;
7. Any nonfunctioning antenna and associated antenna mounting equipment on this facility owned and operated by AT&T shall be removed within 60 days of the date the antenna ceased to function;
8. The validity of this action shall expire one year from the date of this letter; and
9. The Petitioner may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one year deadline provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.

This decision is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Council and is not applicable to any other modification or construction. All work is to be implemented as specified in the EFR dated March 3, 2020. Any minor changes to the eligible facility request require advance notification and approval
