Dear Ms. Bellion:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your email correspondence of June 9, 2020 regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling issued by the Council on July 20, 2018.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Decision of July 20, 2018, your request to perform work from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Friday, June 12, 2020; Saturday, June 13, 2020; Monday, July 13, 2020; and Tuesday, July 14, 2020 is hereby approved.

The extended work hours are necessary to ensure that Eversource can complete its required switching operations during a scheduled outage.

The work will be primarily confined to within the control enclosures. The only noise generated will be from the vehicles driven by the workers to arrive and leave the substation.

This approval applies only to the request for extended work hours in your email of June 9, 2020. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

Eversource seeks Council staff approval for extended work hours for the above referenced project on Friday, June 12 2020, Saturday, June 13, 2020, Monday, July 13, 2020 and Tuesday, July 14, 2020 from 7AM to 10PM. The extended hours are requested to ensure that the required switching operations are completed during the scheduled outage window. This complex switching work involved requires coordination with other on-going activities related to the project. The timing of the switching work with these other activities creates challenges to complete the work during the current allowed work hours.

The work during the extended hours will be primarily inside the control enclosures. The only noise generated will be by the vehicles driven by the workers to arrive and leave the substation.

We have notified the Town of Manchester of our intention to submit this request to the Council and they do not object to these extended work hours.
