Dear Ms. Bachman,

The Town of Waterford has reviewed GRE's responses to the Town's April 12, 2020 comments and interrogatories regarding the referenced petition. The following questions are herein forwarded for response and clarification for the following petition.

**PETITION NO. 1347A** – GRE GACRUX LLC petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 16.78 megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility located at 117 Oil Mill Road and associated electrical interconnection to Eversource Energy's existing substation at 325 Waterford Parkway North in Waterford, Connecticut.

1. Will the final plan include vegetative or other type of visual screening maintained on the subject site to screen the development from abutting and adjacent properties rather than relying on vegetation on other properties not in the petitioner's control?
2. Referring to petitioner's response to Town of Waterford question #22, the petitioner indicates a willingness to copy the Town on all weekly site inspection reports. Please clarify if GRE will include the Town of Waterford on all construction and post-construction site erosion and sediment control and stormwater management/inspection reports.
3. Please indicate whether the Town of Waterford will be allowed to review and comment on the O&M plan and final Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) prior to final approval. Many of the Town's comments regarding final design, construction and maintenance of stormwater treatment basins run-off controls were to be addressed in the final plan documents.
