RE: **PETITION NO. 1406** – Doosan Fuel Cell America, Inc. petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a grid-side 9.66-megawatt fuel cell facility and associated equipment to be located at 600 Iranistan Avenue, Bridgeport, Connecticut, and associated electrical interconnection to the United Illuminating Company's existing Congress Street Substation.

Dear Mr. Provey:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your March 5, 2021 request for Intervenor status in Petition No. 1406. The final decision to deny this petition without prejudice was rendered December 18, 2020.

The Council has not received a motion to reopen this petition for a declaratory ruling for a fuel cell facility. However, if a motion to reopen Petition No. 1406 is submitted, the Council will vote on whether to reopen the petition. If the Council grants the motion to reopen, the Council will also vote on your request for Intervenor status during a Council meeting. A copy of the agenda for the meeting will be sent to you. You will be notified of the Council's determination immediately thereafter.

In reaching a final decision on a petition, the Council carefully considers all the facts contained in the evidentiary record that is development by the Council, petitioner, parties and intervenors to the proceedings, and all the concerns received from members of the public who submit written statements to the Council.

The Council will retain your request for Intervenor status, in the event that a motion to reopen this petition is submitted to the Council.
