Good afternoon, Ms. Lee.

Evan Robidoux from our office forwarded your question about the signs.

Yes, it is normal for the signs to be removed from the proposed site after the first public hearing when the evening public comment session is held. It is consistent with the hearing procedures. Item No. 4 addresses the signs.

Pursuant to Section 16-50j-21 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, at least ten business days prior to the public hearing, the petitioner shall erect and maintain, in a legible condition, a sign not less than six feet by four feet at the entrance to the property from a public road where the proposed facility is to be located. The sign shall set forth the name of the petitioner, the type of facility, the remote public hearing date, and contact information for the Council (Web site and phone number). **The sign shall not be removed from the site until after the commencement of the evening public comment session.**
