In response to your request of August 17, 2020, during a regular meeting held on August 27, 2020, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 22a-19, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) granted the addition of CEPA Intervenor Status in Petition No. 1410 to Douglas Hanson.
