
During our public outreach process in June 2020, and prior to filing a petition with the Connecticut Siting Council, we relied on the Watertown Geographic Information System (GIS) for the identities of any and all abutting property owners. As you can see in the attached, the Watertown GIS mapping system still indicates, incorrectly so, that the owner of a ~68-acre parcel at 279 Hinman Road is Renee Hodge (Attachment 1). Based on this information from the Watertown GIS, we notified Renee Hodge of the project thinking she was the owner of the full ~68-acre parcel. In recent days, we have learned that the ~68-acre parcel known as 279 Hinman Road on the Watertown GIS, was subdivided and that you are the actual owners of the ~65-acre parcel known as 217 Hinman Road. That parcel at 217 Hinman Road abuts a property owned by the Catholic Cemeteries Association of the Archdiocese of Hartford to the east. The proposed solar project, which we refer to as Watertown Solar One, will be located on a small portion of the Catholic Cemeteries Association of the Archdiocese of Hartford property.

Specifically, the proposed project will be located at 669 Platt Road, to the southeast 217 Hinman Road (see Attachment 2). The project's design calls for a 1.975-megawatt system located on approximately 16 acres. The proposed project is intended to be located south of the Mt. Olivet Cemetery. and approximately 1,650 feet from the house at 217 Hinman Road. Based on the Viewshed Analysis (see Attachment 3) that was completed, there are no anticipated views of the proposed solar array from your home or property. Once completed, Watertown Solar One is projected to generate enough energy to power 470 homes for a year, while generating zero pollution or carbon emissions each year.





### Physical Geography / Background Data

A digital surface model (DSM) was created from the State of Connecticut 2016 LiDAR LAS data points. The first return LiDAR LAS values, associated with the highest feature in the landscape (such as a treetop or top of building), were used to capture the natural and built features on the Earth's surface beyond the approximate limits of clearing associated with the proposed solar facility. The "bare-earth" return values were utilized to reflect proposed conditions where vegetative clearing associated with the proposed solar facility would occur.




