Pursuant to the Condition no. 16 of the Council's approval of Petition No. 1424, this letter will serve as notice that ownership of Southington Solar One, LLC has been transferred to DG Connecticut Solar III, LLC, an affiliate of NextEra Energy Resources, LLC, on or about July 20, 2021. Southington Solar One, LLC is still the owner of the facility. The individual responsible for management and operations of the Southington Solar One facility on behalf of DG Connecticut Solar III, LLC will be Tim Garcia, NextEra Energy DG Business Management (Email: <a href="mailto:DL-DG-NEER-BUS-MGT@nexteraenergy.com">DL-DG-NEER-BUS-MGT@nexteraenergy.com</a>). Tim Garcia should be added to the distribution list going forward. Mr. Fitzgerald and Mr. Herchel should remain on the service list.

I also wish to follow up on the August 5, 2021 correspondence. In that letter, we had asked to provide quarterly progress reports on the facility's construction, however, in reviewing the Council's Decision, it has come to our attention that the facility was not required to file a D&M Plan, therefore no progress reports are required. As such, we will not be filing such updates.
