RE: **PETITION NO. 1424** - Southington Solar One, LLC petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 4.725-megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility located at 1012 East Street, Southington, Connecticut, and associated electrical interconnection.

Dear Attorney Zagorsky:

In response to your request of August 27, 2020, during a regular meeting held on September 10, 2020, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50n, §22a-19, and §4-177a, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) granted CEPA Intervenor status and Intervenor status in Petition No. 1424 to Michael and Diane Karabin limiting the Karabins participation under CGS §4-177a(d) to environmental matters that are jurisdictional to the Council pursuant to the Public Utility Environmental Standards Act, which include potential impacts to agriculture, but do not include the evaluation and/or determination of rights under any lease with the property owner of the proposed site.

Please be advised that until further notice, in order to prevent the spread of Coronavirus and protect the health and safety of our members and staff, the Council has converted to full remote operations and has waived the original and 15 hard copy filing requirements. **Please mail one hard copy of any filing to the Council Office for our records.** In accordance with Section 16-50j-12 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies and with the State Solid Waste Management Plan, the Council is requesting that all filings be submitted on recyclable paper, primarily regular weight white office paper. Parties and intervenors are required to serve all other parties and intervenors a copy of any material submitted in this petition, unless service is waived.
