The Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") acknowledged the above referenced Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection ("DESPP") petition and ruled that it, "would not have a substantial adverse environmental effect, and pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50k, would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need". DESPP hereby notifies the Council that construction of the proposed tower is complete, as specified in the original petition. In addition, the pre-existing monopole has been removed. It should be noted that the pre-existing DOT antenna was not installed on the new self-supporting lattice tower as the DOT has discontinued the Highway Advisory Radio (HAR) program that was using the antenna.
