Dear Attorney Bachman:

On May 7th, 2021, the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) approved by declaratory ruling a proposed Bloom Energy Corporation (“Bloom”) fuel cell facility (the “Facility”) at the Yale New Haven/ Lawrence & Memorial Hospital located at 412 Ocean Avenue, New London CT (the “Site”).

Since that time, a minor change has occurred to the underground utility locate, due to the ethernet company looking to pull from a street utility pole and connect to our equipment pad. The last 10' of the conduit run extends beyond the hospital property line into the public right of way. We are respectfully requesting the Council’s review and approval on this change.


