RE: **PETITION NO. 1445** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed 1588 Line Rebuild Project, consisting of the replacement and reconductoring of electric transmission line structures along approximately 2.65 miles of its existing 115-kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line within existing Eversource transmission line right-of-way (ROW) that extends from Wallingford Electric's Colony Substation, located at 15 Old Colony Road, Wallingford and Wallingford Electric's North Wallingford Substation, located at 130 Thorpe Avenue, Wallingford, Connecticut, and related electric transmission line structure improvements.

Dear Ms. Farrell:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated November 29, 2021, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on June 18, 2021.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Declaratory Ruling, your request to perform work from 7:00 am until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, December 5, 2021; Sunday, December 12, 2021; and Sunday, December 19, 2021 is hereby approved.

The Sunday work hours are necessary to complete line work installation before the outage ends on December 23, 2021.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated November 29, 2021. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.
