The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated January 19, 2022 regarding a change to the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was issued by the Council on December 20, 2021.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's December 20, 2021 Declaratory Ruling, your request to install compound security fencing with 2-inch mesh and privacy slats in lieu of security fencing with 1.25-inch mesh (due to supply chain issues) is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the project changes described in your January 19, 2022 correspondence. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.



Dear Attorney Bachman:

As you are aware, the Council approved Petition No. 1470 on December 16, 2021, subject to conditions including, but not limited to, the delegation of “any project changes” to Council staff.

The purpose of this letter is to notify you and the Council that the temporary chain link security fence that will be installed around all of the temporary telecommunications facility improvements will maintain a mesh size of 2” rather than 1 ¼” as referenced on the Construction Plans (Sheet A-6) filed with the Council on December 29, 2021. Cellco learned recently that, due to supply chain issues, 1 ¼” mesh fencing is not available, and it is unclear when it could be acquired.

As you know from the Petition No. 1470 filing, Cellco is under significant time constraints relating to the completion of these temporary telecommunications facility improvements. Our ability to utilize the larger mesh fencing will allow the work to be completed in accordance with the current schedule. At the request of SHU, Cellco will also be installing privacy slats on the temporary facility fence.
