Mr. Clark, Mr. Wood, and Mr. Reid met Mr. Carlson of NUSCO for a final review of Petition No. 42.

This petition involved the installation of one wood pole approximately 83 feet high, and approximately 250 feet of conductors to provide a 115 kV tap from an existing line to the new Brooklyn Substation for 23 kV distribution.

The pole is located in an agricultural field owned by the Connecticut Light and Power Company adjacent to the Quinebaug River. The soil is a well drained Merrimac Sandy loam. Access to the site is an existing farm road. There appears to be no soil disturbance; the area is covered with herbaceous vegetation.

There have been no significant adverse environmental impacts resulting from the construction. Final approval is recommended.
