Storer Broadcasting
March 26, 1985

Storer Broadcasting (Storer) is seeking a declaratory ruling from the Siting Council that a planned replacement tower and expansion of the on-the-ground service building at the existing Killingworth headend does not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need from the Council. Storer previously submitted a petition, No. 112, on this same matter on August 9, 1984.

By letter dated August 23, 1984, the Council requested additional information from Storer. Specifically, the Council required more information regarding: a) a site plan with the exact tower and building locations and layout; b) identification of the specific statutory provisions on which Storer requests a ruling; and c) identification and a signature of the person in whose behalf the inquiry is made. When such information was not forthcoming, the Council, at a meeting on October 9, 1984, voted to deny Storer's request for an advisory ruling because of a lack of complete information on this matter.

The requested information has been included in Petition No. 124 and by additional letter dated March 18, 1985. All other specifics of this petition are identical to those included in Petition No. 112, and noted on the field review of August 20, 1984. According to Attorney Killian, no work has begun at the site.
