Aetna Life & Casualty Company Emergency Generating Devices
Windsor, Connecticut
March 7, 1990

Aetna Life & Casualty Company (Aetna) is requesting the Council to reaffirm its December 13, 1989, ruling which granted Petition 241. The Council's ruling in Petition 241 granted Aetna's request that four proposed 1.25 MW generators would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need because the generators were "emergency generating devices" as defined by Connecticut General Statutes Section 16-50i(f) as amended by Public Act No. 89-61.

Aetna's February 28, 1990, request is made because finalized engineering and site reconnaissance has relocated the emergency generating devices from the north end of the Windsor Site mechanical building to the south end of the mechanical building.

There are no changes in size, capacity, rating, or other parameters proposed by Aetna in Petition 241.
