1. Attendance:

2. Call to Order:

Noting the presence of a quorum, Josh Geballe, Chairperson of the Board, called the meeting to order at 8:36 a.m.

3. Approval of Minutes:

Chairperson Josh Geballe asked the members of the Board to consider the draft minutes from the November 14, 2019 Board meeting. Members voted in favor of adopting the minutes from the meeting as presented.

Motion approved, with Paul Potamianos abstaining because he was absent from the November 14th meeting.

4. Report out from Chairperson Geballe:

Chairperson Josh Geballe reported on the status of the ongoing efforts being made by Daryle Dudzinski from the Department of Labor to arrange for a gap analysis of the proposed unemployment insurance (UI) system as compared to the needs associated with the collection of PFMLIA contributions.

Daryle Dubzinski (on phone) commented that it is an extensive process but moving forward.

Josh reminded the members of the Board to send their bios and headshots to his assistant, Cindy Rusczyk for the Authority's website.

6. **Report out from Erin Choquette:**

Erin Choquette gave a presentation on PFMLIA Responsibilities (presentation attached). After the presentation, the members discussed various issues raised by the presentation.

7. **New Business:**

Paul Potamianos suggested that it would be helpful to have a presentation that provided a detailed analysis of the timeline and planning considerations for the collection of contributions function of the PFMLIA.

Eva Bermudez Zimmerman asked if the board had given any consideration to establishing a technology subcommittee. Chairperson Geballe responded that decisions about procurement options would be presented to the full Board but encouraged members to notify him if they have a particular interest in technology when they sent him their committee preferences.
