## STATE BUILDING CODE INTERPRETATION NO. I-03-12

The following is in response to your request for formal interpretation dated January 20, 2012.

## **Question**:

Paragraph 1021.1, of the 2003 International Building Code portion of the 2005 State Building Code, includes the statement: "..., and where two or more exits are required, not more than one-half of the total number of exits or total exit width shall be horizontal exits."

Is it permissible to install additional doors or doors with width greater than onehalf of the total exit width in the horizontal exit wall provided the additional doors or width are not considered additional exits or exit width?

## Answer:

Yes, the 2005 State Building Code would not prohibit this.
