STATE BUILDING CODE INTERPRETATION NO. I-13-08

The following is offered in response to your email dated July 28, 2008 in which you seek a formal interpretation of the provisions of Section 106.1.5, of the 2003 International Building Code portion of the 2005 State Building Code.

Question: Referencing the 2005 State Building Code, Section 106.1.5, what is the threshold limit for a parking structure? Is it related to height? Stories? Square footage? Number of occupants? Or is it simply 1,000 cars regardless of the other parameters?

Answer: Section 29-276(c), of the Connecticut General Statutes, is cited in Section 106.1.5. I am not authorized to provide official interpretations of statute, and I thus decline to do so.
