8. APPEAL HEARINGS

- a. A-34-04. Appeal of Steven Edelman re State Building Inspector's decision re 9/1/04 State Building Inspector's decision under 29-252(d) CGS. Appellant contacted DCS Legal Counsel and requested this appeal be re-opened. On 12/10/14 noted for the record: John Butkus, Louis Free, Robert Hanbury, Donald Harwood, Michael Musco and Glenn Neilson are recused. This is a request to re-open an appeal that had been decided. On 1/14/15, appellant's request to re-open this appeal and applicable State Statute was forwarded to members for review. Motion was made and seconded to deny the appellant's request to re-open this appeal. Noted for the record: John Butkus, Louis Free, Robert Hanbury, Donald Harwood, Michael Musco and Glenn Neilson recused themselves. All in favor. None opposed. Motion carried. Legal counsel will draft letter to appellant.

John Butkus, Louis Free, Robert Hanbury, Donald Harwood, Michael Musco, Glenn Neilson and Marjorie Shansky are recused. Panel consists of Henry Miga, Panel Chair; Anthony Bruno and George Iskra. David McKinley will be the alternate. Panel will review 29-252(d) as it applies to this appeal. If panel determines aggrievement, then appeal hearing may immediately follow to consider the merits of this appeal. Hearing set for June 16, 2014, was not held; on 6/12/14 appellant requested postponement. Aggrievement hearing set for November 12, 2014 was not held; on 11/10/14 appellant requested postponement. On 9/2/14 correspondence received from appellant requesting postponement; Lawrence Stannard, Marlborough Building Official, granted appellant a 30 day extension (until 10/8/14). Hearing was held on November 12, 2014. **Decision will be sent out within 90 days [by February 12, 2015.] Hold on agenda.**
- f. A-10-14. Appeal from Bruce Spiewak re State Fire Marshal's decision re FM-0263-14 re Sandy Hook School, Building 2, 12 Dickinson Drive, Newtown, CT. Appeal panel was not set. On 10/8/14 appellant requested appeal be tabled until the November meeting. On 12/10/14 appellant requested this appeal be postponed until a draft determination is made by the Codes Amendment Subcommittee re what parts of Chapter 10 (Fire Code and Building Code) will be recommended for approval. Reason for modification denial stated in part that, "C&S had not addressed that section of the code yet." Hold on agenda.
