## a. Staff Report

Joe Cassidy, OSBI, advised that there are 2 vacant positions advertised for the Office of the State Building Inspector's Office.

#### b. Fire Prevention Code Advisory Committee (Harwood)

Jenna Padula advised that the Fire Prevention Code Advisory Committee code is progressing through the approval process and is on the 3/24/15 Regulations Review agenda. She advised the Fire Marshal qualifications/certifications of local fire officials just went to Regs Review and might be on their May agenda.

c. Joint Building Code Training Council (Musco)/ Fire Marshal Training Council (Harwood)/ (aka Joint BCTC/FMTC) There was no report.

#### d. Report on Bills

A discussion was held regarding pending bills pertaining to accessibility, disconnects and 10 year smoke detectors. There will be a public hearing on Residential Fire Sprinklers coming up.

Joe Cassidy advised that HB 6972 proposes to change the C&S membership make-up of 2 Public Members to be 2 local Fire Marshals. There will be a public hearing on this tomorrow. A lengthy discussion ensued regarding parity, balance and diversity offered in the current C&S make-up. Motion was made and seconded to vote on whether the proposed bill [HB 6972] should be adopted or rejected and, whatever the vote is, to carry it forward to the committee [Public Safety and Security Committee]. A discussion followed re examples of committee standing to vote as a full committee and to have the Chair of the committee represent C&S. Motion was amended to include that if the Chair goes and testifies to oppose the bill, the testimony has to be based on the fact that the current make-up and balance of that make-up is what C&S members are concerned about, that the C&S Committee does not think it is needed, articulate current make-up is fair and balanced and representation by increasing the number in one group is disproportionate and is not the reflection of the C&S Committee. Motion as amended accepted by maker and seconded. All in favor; 2 opposed [Sinsigalli and Flood]. Motion carried.

e. **Public Member Vacancy:** Joe Cassidy reported that they have received several letters of interest and resume backgrounds that will be discussed with the Commissioner so she can make a nomination.

#### 8. APPEAL HEARINGS

- a. A-34-04. Appeal of Steven Edelman re State Building Inspector's decision re 9/1/04 State Building Inspector's decision under 29-252(d) CGS. Appellant contacted DCS Legal Counsel and requested this appeal be re-opened. On 12/10/14 noted for the record: John Butkus, Louis Free, Robert Hanbury, Donald Harwood, Michael Musco and Glenn Neilson are recused. This is a request to re-open an appeal that had been decided. On 1/14/15, appellant's request to re-open this appeal and applicable State Statute was forwarded to members for review. Motion was made and seconded to deny the appellant's request to re-open this appeal. Noted for the record: John Butkus, Louis Free, Robert Hanbury, Donald Harwood, Michael Musco and Glenn Neilson recused themselves. All in favor. None opposed. Motion carried. Legal counsel will draft letter to appellant. Hold on agenda.
- b. A-4-10. Appeal from Steven Edelman re Windham Building Official's decision re 202 Scotland Road, Windham, CT. John Butkus, Louis Free, Robert Hanbury, Donald Harwood, Michael Musco, Glenn Neilson and Marjorie Shansky are recused. On June 21, 2010 a postponement was granted as a result of appellant's request for a stay of the proceedings. On January 24, 2013 correspondence received from appellant. On 6/3/14 certified letter sent to appellant requesting status of appeal and to respond in writing by 6/17/14. Hearing set for November 12, 2014 was not held; on 11/10/14 appellant requested postponement. Hearing was held on February 4, 2015. Decision will be sent out within 90 days [by May 4, 2015]. Hold on agenda.
- c. A-28-11. Appeal from Steven Edelman re Acting State Building Inspector's decision re 29-252(d) re Town of Windham Building permit application re 202 Scotland Road, Windham, CT. John Butkus, Louis Free, Robert Hanbury, Donald Harwood, Michael Musco, Glenn Neilson and Marjorie Shansky are recused. Panel consists of Henry Miga, Panel Chair; Anthony Bruno and George Iskra. David McKinley will be the alternate. Panel will review 29-252(d) as it applies to this appeal. If panel determines aggrievement, then appeal hearing may immediately follow to consider the merits of this appeal. Hearing set for June 16, 2014, was not held; on 6/12/14 appellant requested postponement. Aggrievement hearing set for November 12, 2014 was not held; on 11/10/14 appellant requested postponement. Hearing was held and closed on February 4, 2015. The parties were given 7 working days [until February 17, 2015] to submit briefs. On 2/17/15 received Motion for Continuance and CGS 29-262(d) Petition from appellant. Deliberations were set for Wednesday, April 8, 2015 at 12:00 in G38.

- d. A-19-13. Appeal from Jeffrey Reiner re West Hartford Fire Marshal's decision re 25 Stanley Street, West Hartford, CT. Michael Sinsigalli is recused. Panel consists of Keith Flood, Panel Chair; Glenn Neilson and Carlton Smith. Christopher Cozzi will be the alternate. Hearing to address timeliness and aggrieved party issues set for March 12, 2014 was postponed; on 2/21/14 appellant requested postponement. Aggrievement and timeliness hearing was rescheduled to April 9, 2014; on 3/3/14 appellant requested second postponement. Aggrievement and timeliness hearing was rescheduled to May 14, 2014 in room G38, in Hartford. Appeal hearing may immediately follow. As of 5/14/14 appeal panel is awaiting commentary from legal advisor re timeliness of appeal before rendering their decision. On 11/7/14 correspondence from Michael Sinsigalli requesting action be taken on this appeal. Aggrievement and timeliness hearing were held on December 22, 2014. Decision will be sent out within 90 days [by March 22, 2015]. Hold on agenda.

On 12/10/14 appellant requested this appeal be postponed until a draft determination is made by the Codes Amendment Subcommittee re what parts of Chapter 10 (Fire Code and Building Code) will be recommended for approval.
