**MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL POLICY NO. 87-1**

**TO: AGENCY HEADS**

**SUBJECT: Benefit Change - Meal Allowance and Hazardous Duty Stipend  
for State Police Excluded from Bargaining**

In accordance with Connecticut General Statute 5-200(r), the Commissioner of Administrative Services with the approval of the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management has extended the following benefit to all sworn State Police personnel who are excluded from bargaining. This change may affect employees in the classes of Trooper, Trooper First Class, Sergeant, Master Sergeant, Lieutenant, Captain, Major, Lieutenant Colonel, Deputy Commissioner and Commissioner.

A. Meal Allowance

Effective 7/3/87, the meal allowance increases to **\$11.00.**

Effective 7/15/88, the meal allowance increases to **\$11.75.**

Effective 7/14/89, the meal allowance increases to **\$12.22.**

B. Hazardous Duty Stipend - Effective July 1, 1987

A monthly stipend of **\$100.00**, shall be paid to employees assigned to and performing the following hazardous duties:

Pilot, diver, tactical services (SWAT), and hazardous devices (bomb squad).

There shall be no pyramiding of stipend for employees assigned to and performing more than one hazardous duty.
